

DP Camps in Italy

When the IRO took over the responsibility for looking after DPs in 1947, there were 22 DP camps in Italy. The codes for the individual camps can also be found on the cards of the IRO Italy. The list below was created on the basis of a number of sources and provides an initial overview of which code was assigned to which DP camp. However, it is not exhaustive. Neither has there been any research to date on whether the codes changed during the period when the IRO was responsible for DPs in Italy.
